## Why Study in Alberta Video Contest

### Contest Rules (the "Rules")

#### **Eligibility:**

1. To be eligible, your video must not exceed TWO MINUTES in length, must be in mp4 video format, and must not exceed 50MB.
2. Each Entrant/Team may only enter one original video. **If a Team is submitting a video entry, each team member must complete the Declaration and Official Entry Form.**
3. Except for Alberta Education employees and their immediate family members, this contest is open to all youth residing in Alberta, and studying in Grades 9 to 12.
4. Your video must be entirely your own original creation, which includes music, artwork and other graphic images. It must not infringe upon or violate any laws or any third party rights, including, but not limited to, copyright, patent, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary rights and must not lead to any cause of action including libel, defamation, privacy violation, contract breach or tort. Entrants/Teams must obtain all necessary permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and other approvals from third parties (including but not limited to all copyright holders and all individuals appearing in the video submission), necessary to use the video submission, in whole or in part, in any way, including without limitation, to reproduce, make derivatives, edit, modify, translate, distribute, transmit, publish, license and broadcast the video submission worldwide, by any means. Any and all such permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and approvals must be attached with your video entry.

#### **General Information:**

5. Your own personal safety and the safety of your cast, crew and others involved with the production of the Video submission must be maintained. Do not endanger anyone during the making of your Video.
6. Prizes to be awarded in this Contest will be as follows and may change;
  - 1<sup>st</sup> prize: i-Pad
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: i-Pod Touch
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> prize: Backpack
  - Many more prizes will be awarded
7. Alberta Education may contact Entrants/Teams of winning Videos to obtain a photograph of the Entrant/Team, without further compensation, for use in any Alberta Education advertisement, publication or promotion, for general news or other information purposes.
8. The chances of winning a prize depend on the total number and quality of eligible entries received prior to the closing date.
9. Alberta Education reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest for any reason, without any prior notice to any Entrant/Team.

### **Selection of Awards:**

10. All incoming entries will be judged by a panel of judges chosen by Alberta Education.
11. Decisions on all matters relating to the Contest are final and not open to dispute.
12. Entries will be judged on originality, quality, and effectiveness of the message.
13. Each Entrant/Team who has submitted a winning entry will be notified by telephone that their entry has won and informed of the procedure to follow to claim the applicable prize. If an Entrant/Team declines the prize, the prize may be forfeited and awarded to another. A list of winning Videos will be posted on [speakout.alberta.ca](http://speakout.alberta.ca) website.
14. If Alberta Education does not receive entries of sufficient quantity or quality, Alberta Education reserves the right not to award any prizes.
15. Top selected videos will be posted on the Study in Alberta website and Speak Out website, and be used during Alberta Education's international missions.

### **Entry Information:**

16. Each Entrant/Team may only submit one Video submission. Multiple entries will not be accepted.
17. Your Video submission must be received by Alberta Education by March 30, 2012.

21. If any copyright or permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and approvals were obtained, please enclose these with your Video entry. Alberta Education is not responsible for entries which are delayed, lost, misdirected, incomplete, damaged or destroyed. Any entry that is tampered with, unreadable or mutilated will not be accepted. PLEASE SEND ALBERTA EDUCATION A DUPLICATE COPY OF YOUR VIDEOTAPE. DO NOT SEND YOUR ONLY COPY.
22. If you require confirmation that Alberta Education has received and accepted your entry, include your e-mail address on the completed entry form. Alberta Education will try to advise you that your entry was received.

23. For the purpose of these Rules, each properly labeled Video submission accompanied by a properly completed Official Entry Form shall be considered a valid entry.
24. These Rules may be changed without notice or reason including, if necessary, to comply with any applicable law. By entering this Contest, Entrants/Teams agree to abide by these rules and acknowledge that Alberta Education shall not be responsible for any damages, costs, demands, claims or losses of any kind, incurred by any party as a result of participation in Alberta Education's Student Video Contest.
25. Any false information provided within the context of the Contest by any Entrant/Team concerning information provided in the Official Entry Form, ownership of right or non-compliance with the rules or the like may result in the immediate elimination of the Entrant/Team from the Contest.
26. This Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with these Rules, the laws of the Province of Alberta and any applicable federal laws. These Rules govern all aspects of the Contest and are binding on all Entrants/Teams and all other parties including parents and legal guardians, who sign the Declaration or Official Entry Form.
